10000 FEET AND DOING 300 MPH , BEAU GRADUALLY OVERTOOK

DOING A SHALLOW DIVE AT 320 I A S MOMENTARY CONTACT OBTAINED ON

F/A CROSSINGSTARBOARD TO PORT AT 10000 FEET RANGE . AFTER

ANOTHER VECTOR FROM MIXTURE AND DECREASE HEIGHT TO 7000 FEET

ANOTHER CONTACT WAS OBTAINED AT MAXIMUM RANGE ON E/A AHEAD

SLIGHTLY TO STARBOARD AT SAME HEIGHT . BEAU CLOSED IN RAPIDLY

BEHIND . AT 4000 FEET THROTTLED RIGHT BACK AND LOWERED UNDERCARRIAG

CONTINUED TO CLOSE IN SLOWLY RAISED UNDERCARRIAGE AND AT 2000 FEET

BETAINED VISUAL OF JUSS EXHAUSTS 500 FEET ADDITION TO THE STATE OF THE

500 FEET ABOVE AND 5 DEG TO STARBOARD . CLOSED IN TO 250 YARDS

SLIGHTLY BENEATH ND DEAD ASTERN IDENTIFYING E/A AS JUSS .
